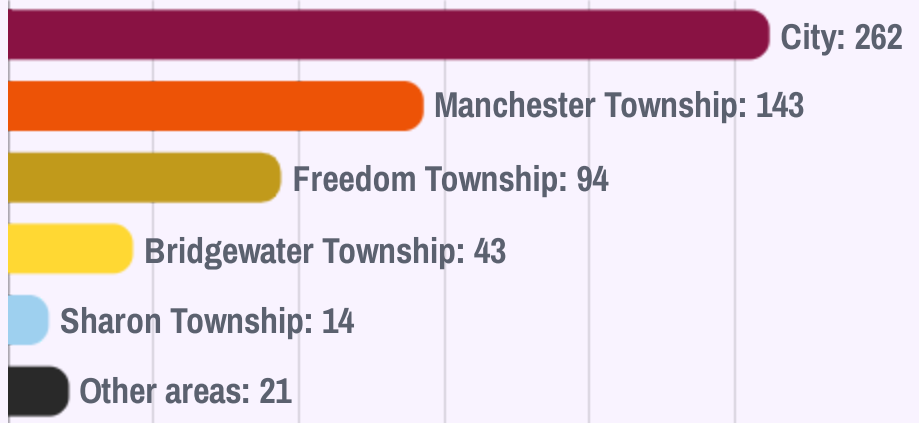

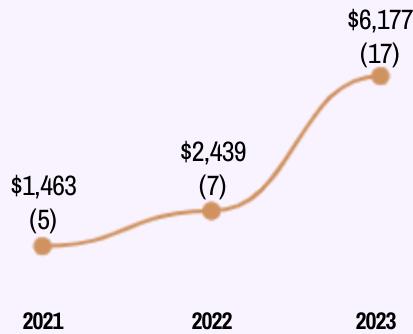

Food Pantry Visits Per Area

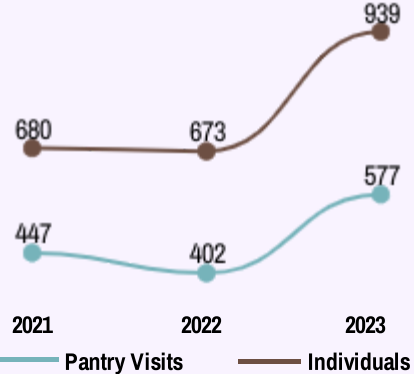


Financial Assistance



Household emergency funding requests were up **129% over 2022**. Households were assisted with emergency funding to prevent eviction, utilities from being shut off or loss of transportation for employment.

Pantry Visits 2021-2023



Pantry visits were up **44% over 2022**. With the rising costs of food, people were able to get the basics and have funds for other expenses.

MI Bridges



CRC assisted 32 clients to apply for or renew and maintain health insurance, food assistance, childcare benefits and/or state emergency relief funds.

This is a **60% increase** from 2022.

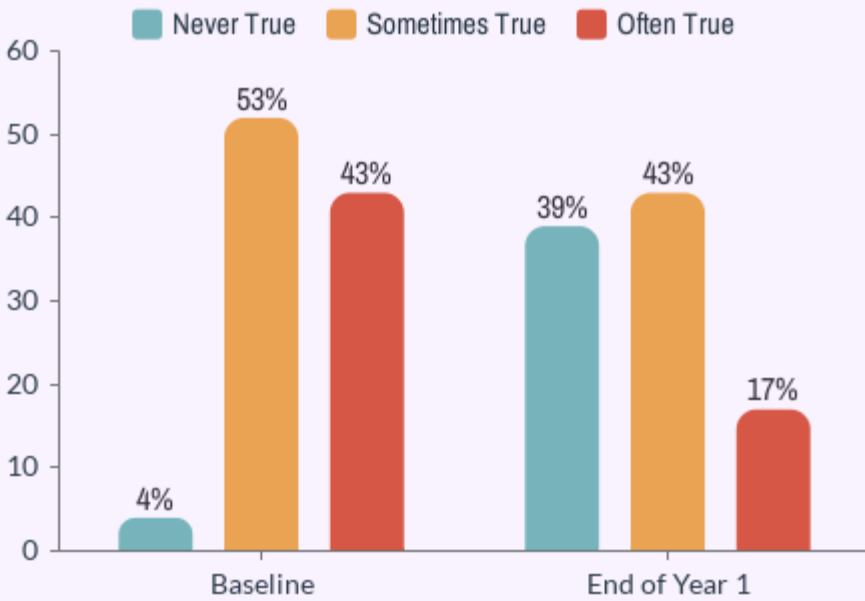

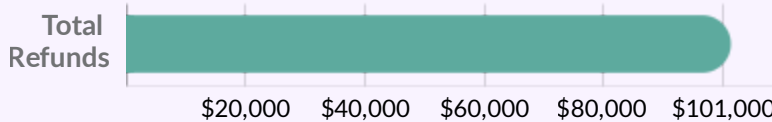
Food Security Improved in Manchester Area

To measure food security, CRC clients were asked how often this statement was true: "this month, the food you bought just didn't last and you didn't have enough money to buy more". As illustrated in the chart below, CRC clients whose food insecurity was measured in July and November 2023 were able to increase their food security. (n=23)

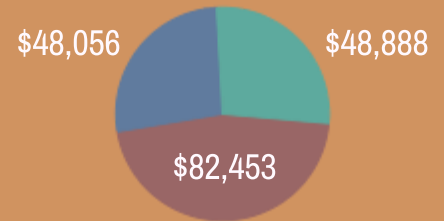
