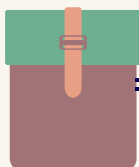

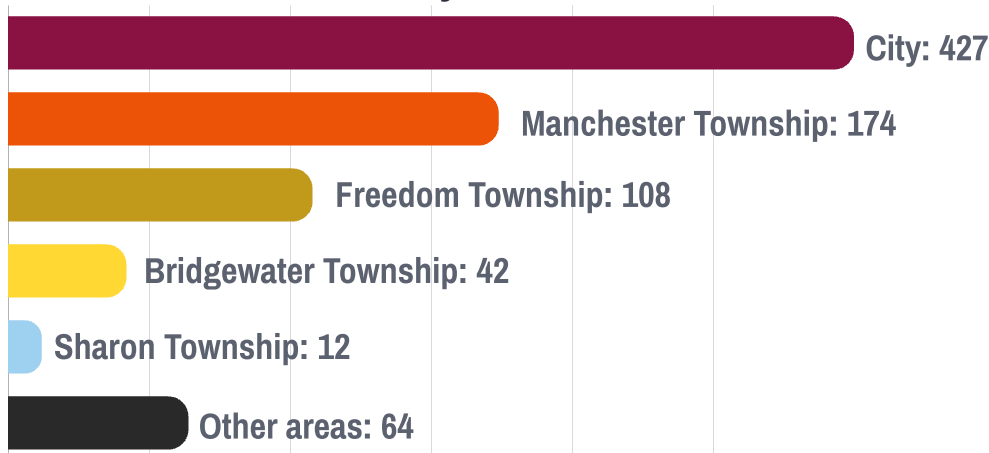
CRC clients purchased fresh, local produce at the Manchester Farmers Market using Wooden Nickels, while supporting local vendors.

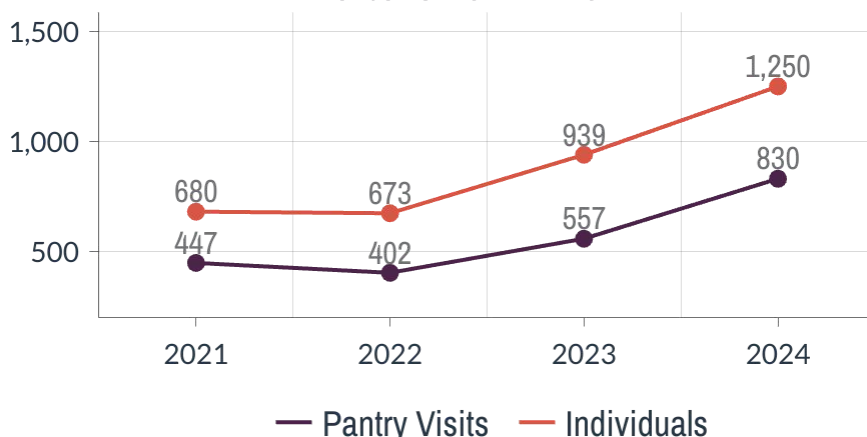


CRC clients and their families received tickets to participate in this community meal.

Food Pantry Visits Per Area

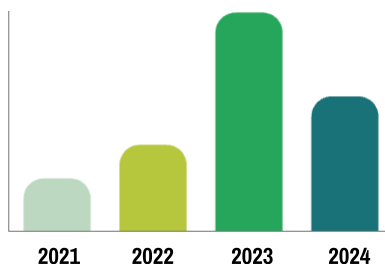


Visits Over Time



In 2024, pantry visits increased by 44% compared to 2023. With rising costs of food and basic goods, people were able to meet their nutritional needs through the pantry while preserving funds for other essential expenses.

Financial Assistance



Household emergency funding requests were lower in 2024 than in 2023. Households were assisted with emergency funding to prevent eviction, utilities from being shut off or loss of transportation for employment.

CRC assisted 39 clients to apply for or renew and maintain health insurance, food assistance, childcare benefits, and state emergency relief funds.

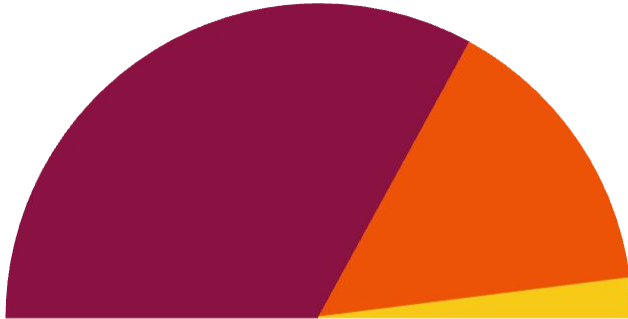

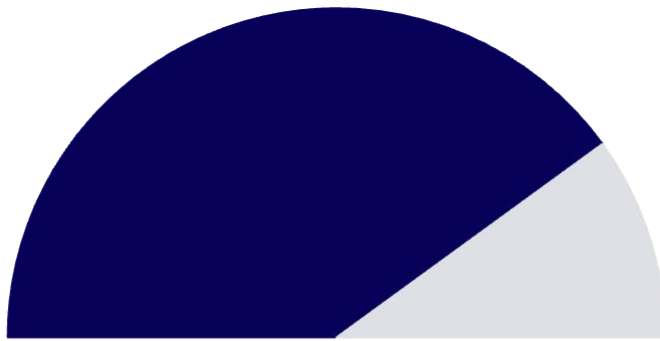

Our surplus income has been added to reserve funds to ensure we are prepared for future opportunities and challenges.

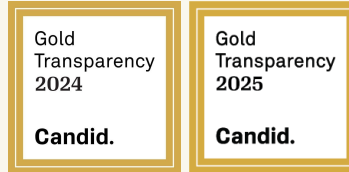
Expenses: \$184,876
